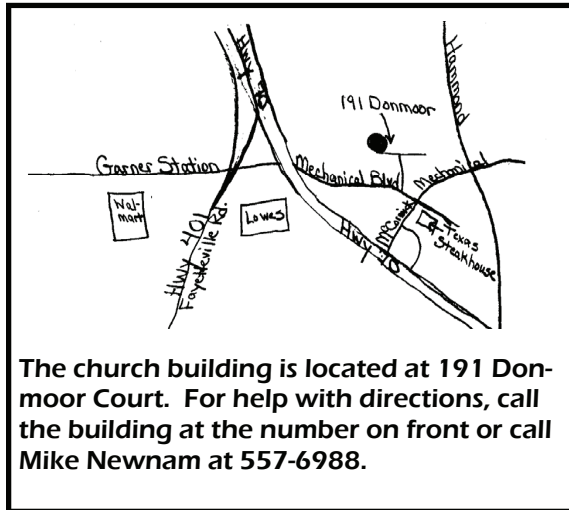

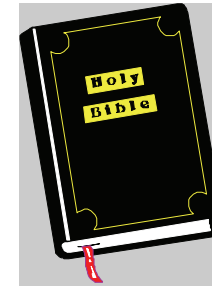


The Bible tells us there are several appointments we all must keep. Every one of us will make these appointments. They are:

WHO WE ARE.....

We became the South Wake Church of Christ on December 31, 2000. There are twelve families (30 individuals) presently worshipping together. We first began worshipping in different members' homes. In order to promote consistency, we started meeting in the same home on Sundays. We continued there until we located a building on Hwy 401 South. We remained there until we found our present location at 191 Donmoor Court in November 2001. We are looking for a building or land to purchase in the near future.

We began South Wake Church of Christ from the New Testament example in Acts chapter 2. It is our mission to become as strong as the Church was in its beginning. We desire to grow in the strength and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ in every way. It is our prayer to share the gospel in the Garner area and throughout the world.

WHAT WE BELIEVE.....

As a New Testament Church we believe that the Bible teaches one must **Hear** the word, (*"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" Matt 28:19*), **Believe** the Word (*"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned". Mark 16:15-16*), **Repent** from your sins (*"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Acts 2:38*), **Confess** your faith (*"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead,*

thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed." **Rom 10:9-11**), be **Baptized** by immersion for the remission of sins. (*"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."* **Acts 2:38**), **Acts 8:36-39**), **Live Faithfully** serving the Lord (*Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord. I Cor. 15:58*), (Rev. 2:10). We believe that **Singing** (acapella) (Eph. 5:19, Col 3:16), **Prayer** (Eph 6:18), and **Giving** are all part of worship (I Cor.16:2).

Of course, prayer and giving is not limited to just the services. The Bible teaches us that **prayer** is very important in our lives. It gives those who have been added to the Church the ability to request and receive blessings. Through prayer we can make known our needs (Phil 4:6). The Bible teaches us that **giving** of our means is an expression of faith and love for our Lord and His work. (I Cor. 16:2).

We believe and observe the example of taking of the **Lord's Supper** each first day of the week. (Acts 20:7). We believe all scripture is the inspired word of God. It is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness (2 Tim. 3:16). We believe members of the congregation should submit names of men (**only**) they believe qualify for the position of **Deacon** (I Tim. 3:10,13) and **Elder** (bishop, presbytery) (I Tim. 3:1).

WHAT TO EXPECT.....

We have Bible study each Sunday morning starting at 10:00 am and worship service starting at 11:00 am. We have Sunday night worship at 6:00 pm and Wednesday night services starting at 7:00 pm. Our Sunday services consist of singing, prayer, a sermon, the Lord's Supper, giving, and the invitation being offered. On Wednesday night, we have Bible study followed by singing, prayer, a devotional, and the invitation being offered. We want to extend the Lord's invitation each time we come together.

You can expect to find us always striving to grow. We wish to train our **hearts** to be subject to God's inspired word. We want our **hearts** to be pure and holy. We desire to lay up treasures in heaven, not on earth. (Matt. 6:21) We know that from out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. "A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things." (Matt. 12:34-35)

Though we by no means wish to dictate which version of the Bible you use, we teach and preach from the King James and the New King James Versions. In so doing, you can expect continuity from the pulpit and Bible classes.

It is our hope and prayer that this brochure has provided you with enough information for you to determine if you would like to worship with the South Wake Church of Christ.
